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| Unit Description | <p>What's assessed: Aspects of Hispanic society Artistic culture in the Hispanic world Multiculturalism in Hispanic society Aspects of political life in Hispanic society Grammar</p> <p>Questions: Section A: Listening and writing – multiple choice, choosing the 2 true statements, writing a summary about a passage listened to (90 words max), writing answers in Spanish about what you have listened to (30 marks)</p> <p>Section B: Reading and writing – true/ false / not mentioned, writing a summary about a written text (90 words max), writing answers in Spanish about texts, finding synonyms (50 marks)</p> <p>Translations English – Spanish (10 marks), Spanish - English (10 marks)</p> | <p>What's assessed: One text - Réquiem por un campesino español One film – Volver Grammar</p> <p>Questions: One essay question in Spanish on a set text from a choice of two questions (40 marks) One essay question in Spanish on a set film from a choice of two questions (40 marks)</p> | <p>What's assessed : Individual research project Speaking card - One of the four themes from Paper 1</p> <p>Questions: Discussion of a sub-theme based on a stimulus card (5–6 minutes). The student studies the card for 5 minutes at the start of the test (25 marks).</p> <p>Presentation (2 minutes) and discussion (9–10 minutes) of Individual Research Project (35 marks).</p> |
