



Music A Level changes

Performance duration reduced

- Students now need to **perform one or more pieces of music** with a combined, minimum duration of at **least three and a half minutes**.
- A complete, unedited recording of the live performance must be submitted with the score or lead sheet for that performance (if available).
- Recordings may, this year, be made at any time during the course up to the submission deadline.

Composition duration reduced

- **Students now need to compose one piece of music with a duration of at least two minutes**.
- Compositions may be in response to a set brief or be freely composed.
- Students should set a suitable tempo for their chorales and aim to meet the minimum length.
- Submissions must include a complete recording of the composition with a score, lead sheet or written account produced by the student.
- Students don't have to perform their own composition.
- The recording may be computer generated.
- Examiners will mark the piece out of 25.
