

### Trousers

- Plain black belt (if worn)

They must NOT be fashion shoes, or boots, NOT suede or canvass.





### Coats

- Students must always bring a coat to school with them. The weather may change during the day!
- Warm and waterproof! No hoodies.
- It must NOT be made of corduroy, canvas or leather. No camouflage!
- Coats with "football/rugby or club logos" are NOT allowed.

- They must be waterproof.







Throughout the year there will be many opportunities for individuals and classes to be recognised for their reading achievements.


Each week a reading league table will be sent out via SMHW to show which classes have earned the most points.
