Prior to commencing the formal NEA time learners will be allocated 2 hours of preparation and research time. This 2-hour time period is entirely open book where learners can access their teaching and learning materials, text books, internet and other published materials. From this they should develop a research support pack which can be used as their source of information when completing the NEA. Learners can create 4 sides of A4 notes which they can take into the NEA with them for the remaining 14 hours of tasks.	The written exam is a terminal assessment and will assess the learner's knowledge and understanding of all content areas
