Qualification Title: NCFE CACHE Level 1/2 Technical Award in Child Development and Care in the Early Years

Students learn 9 content areas, these are:

- Content area 1 Child development
- Content area 2 Factors that influence the child's development
- Content area 3 Care routines, play and activities to support the child
- Content area 4 Early years provision
- Content area 5 Legislation, policies and procedures in the early years
- Content area 6 Expectations of the early year's practitioner
- Content area 7 Roles and responsibilities within early years settings
- Content area 8 The importance of observations in early years childcare
- Content area 9 Planning in early years childcare

Students' knowledge and understanding of these topics is examined as follows:

Non-Examined Assessment (NEA) <i>Externally set. Internally marked and externally moderated.</i>	Examined Assessment <i>Externally set. Written examination. Externally marked</i>
<p>50% of the award</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">– 92 marks– The completion time for the NEA is 14 hours plus 2 hours preparation and research time. <p>All of the NEA will be completed in normal class time within scheduled assessment hours and will be spread over a number of weeks.</p> <p>Prior to commencing the formal NEA time learners will be allocated 2 hours of preparation and research time. This 2-hour time period is entirely open book where learners can access their teaching and learning materials, text books, internet and other published materials. From this they should develop a research support pack which can be used as their source of information when completing the NEA. Learners can create 4 sides of A4 notes which they can take into the NEA with them for the remaining 14 hours of tasks.</p>	<p>50% of the award</p> <p>Written examination:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">– 80 marks– 1 hour 30 minutes– A mixture of multiple-choice, short-answer and extended-response questions <p>The written exam is a terminal assessment and will assess the learner's knowledge and understanding of all content areas</p>

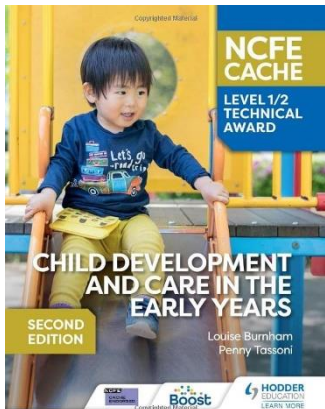
