
When I'm not at school I love spending time with my family and getting out in to the peak district either walking or on my bike. I have a passion for sailing and try to go sailing with friends once a year.

I have been at Notre Dame for over 16 years and teaching for over 20. I am passionate about both Computing & Business and have real interest in finding about new innovations in both subjects.







My favourite sports are cricket and football (I support Sheffield Wednesday).


