Dear Parent/Carer,

Notre Dame High School offers high quality individual instrumental and vocal lessons as an optional extra for students. These lessons take place during the school day and are taught by visiting self-employed music teachers and/or staff from Sheffield Music Hub. Students are withdrawn from a curriculum lesson on a fixed rota system.

Because the teachers are self-employed, **invoices and payments are handled directly between you and the teacher/organisation**, not through the school.

Pricing & Invoicing

- All pricing information is available on the page overleaf.
- If fees change, teachers will notify you at least one term in advance.
- Teachers invoice at the start of each half term, and payment is expected before the second lesson (usually via BACS).
- As this is a private arrangement with the teacher, please contact them directly with any payment queries.

Attendance & Cancellations

- If your child misses a lesson without advance notice, the lesson will normally still be charged.
- Please inform the instrumental teacher of any known absences (including clashes with GCSE assessments) at least one week before the scheduled lesson.
- If a teacher needs to cancel a lesson, it will be rearranged.

Stopping Lessons

If your child wishes to stop lessons, **half a term's written notice** must be given directly to the instrumental teacher. Without this notice, you will still be charged for half a term's fees.

Ensembles

As your child progresses, they may be invited to join a lunchtime ensemble to support their musical development.
